



GTT notified by Hyundai Heavy Industries for the tank design of a new LNG Carrier for Capital Gas Carriers

Paris – May 6th, 2019. GTT has received an order notification from the Korean shipyard Hyundai Heavy Industries (HHI), concerning the tank design of a new 174,000 m³ LNGC, on behalf of Greek ship-owner Capital Gas Carriers.

GTT will design the tanks of the vessel, which will be fitted with the <u>Mark III Flex</u> membrane containment system, a technology developed by GTT. The delivery of the ship is planned during the third quarter of 2021.

Philippe Berterottière, Chairman and CEO of GTT, declared: "We are very happy to receive this new order from our long-term partner HHI and to continue to accompany Capital Gas Carriers in its development in the LNG industry."
