GTT receives orders to design the tanks of eight new LNG carriers

Paris – September 4th, 2019. GTT has received several orders concerning the tank design of eight new LNG carriers. Seven of the LNGCs will be built by the Korean Shipyard Samsung Heavy Industries (SHI) on behalf of three ship-owners based in America, Oceania and Bermuda.

GTT's <u>Mark III Flex</u> technology has been selected to equip the LNG tanks of six LNGCs ordered by SHI and the <u>Mark III Flex+</u> technology to equip the seventh. Each unit will offer a 174,000 m³ capacity. The delivery of the vessels is scheduled between the end of 2021 and the end of 2022.

The information concerning the eighth LNGC remains confidential at this stage.
