GTT receives an order from DSME for the tank design of three new LNG Carriers

Paris – April, the 19th 2022. GTT announces that it has received, in March 2022, an order from its partner the Korean shipyard DSME for the tank design of three new LNGCs¹.

GTT will design the tanks of these LNG carriers, with a total LNG tank capacity of 200,000 m³ per ship. Each tank will be fitted with the GTT NO96 membrane containment system.

Delivery of the vessels is scheduled during the last quarter of 2025.
