



GTT notified by HSHI for the tank design of two new LNG carriers for CMM

Paris – December 13th, 2018. GTT has received an order notification from the Korean shipyard Hyundai Samho Heavy Industries (HSHI) for the tank design of two new 174,000 m³ LNG carriers (LNGC). These units will be built on behalf of the Greek ship-owner Consolidated Marine Management (CMM). The vessels' delivery are scheduled between the first and the third quarter of 2021.

The LNG tanks of the vessels will be equipped with the well-known Mark III Flex containment system developed by GTT.

Philippe Berterottière, Chairman and CEO of GTT declared: "We are pleased with the long-term partnership of excellence developed with HSHI, and to accompany Consolidated Marine Management for its entry in the LNG world."
