GTT receives its first order of 2021, from Samsung Heavy Industries for the tank design of a new LNG Carrier

Paris – January 18th, 2021. GTT has received an order from the Korean shipyard Samsung Heavy Industries (SHI) for the tank design of a new 174,000 m³ LNGC¹ on behalf of the Korean ship-owner Pan Ocean.

GTT will design the tank, which will be fitted with the <u>Mark III Flex</u> membrane containment system. The delivery of this vessel is scheduled for the second quarter of 2023.

This order is the first of the year for GTT. It follows a series of 29 LNG carriers orders received in the second half of 2020. GTT recalls that these orders, except for one, will be delivered over a longer period than usual, spreading over 2023 to 2025.
