



## GTT receives a new order from SHI to design the tanks of two LNG carriers on behalf of Gaslog

**Paris – January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019.** GTT announces it has received an order from the Korean shipyard Samsung Heavy Industries (SHI) for the tank design of two LNG carriers, on behalf of the ship-owner Gaslog.

Each offering a capacity of 180,000 m<sup>3</sup>, the tanks will be fitted with the Mark III Flex+ containment system. The vessels' delivery is expected for Q2 and Q3 of 2021 respectively.

Philippe Berterottière, Chairman and CEO of GTT, declared: "We are pleased to receive this new order from two long term partners, SHI and Gaslog, which confirms the success encountered by our latest Mark III technology evolution."
