



GTT receives notification for the order of two new LNG carriers

Paris – May 16, 2018. GTT has received an order notification from an Asian shipyard for the design of the LNG tanks of two new LNG carriers (LNGCs). These vessels will be built on behalf of a European shipowner.

GTT will design the LNG tanks of both units, each equipped with the NO96 GW containment system proven technology developed by GTT. Their delivery is expected in 2020.

GTT (Gaztransport & Technigaz) is an engineering company expert in containment systems with cryogenic membranes used to transport and store liquefied gas, in particular LNG (Liquefied Natural Gas).
