



Gastech: GTT promotes its latest innovations in technologies and related services

Paris –October 30, 2015. GTT, the world leader in the design of membrane containment systems for the maritime transportation and storage of LNG (Liquefied Natural Gas), brought together more than a hundred LNG industry representatives for a working seminar at the Gastech International Conference & Exhibition in Singapore between October 27 and 30.

GTT used the opportunity to showcase its latest technology innovations and services developed for the shipping and storage of LNG, and for the promising LNG marine fuel market.

The latest developments in GTT membrane technologies, with the Mark V and NO96 Max systems designed specifically to improve boil-off rates, received an extremely positive reception from delegates. Mark V technology, an optimized version of the Mark III system and its Mark III Flex evolution, has received a third general approval, this time from the classification society Bureau Veritas, following on from the previous approvals granted in September by DNV- GL and Lloyd's Register.

The introduction of the new LNG Advisor system for monitoring the boil-off gas released by LNG in transit also generated high levels of interest amongst shipowners and charter operators.

The two in-principle approvals received in recent days for its 4,000 m3 bunkering vessel concept equipped with Mark III Flex membrane confinement technology and operated at maximum gas pressures of up to 2 barg were seen as a significant contribution to developing the LNG fuel market.

Philippe Berterottière, Chairman and CEO of GTT, said: "We are very happy to have had this opportunity to present details of our latest advances in technology to our customers. The very productive discussions we have had with them have given us an even clearer understanding of the challenges and expectations of the LNG chain, which therefore helps us to focus our commitment to innovation so that we can deliver responses that are attractive not only operationally, but also financially."
